

Post Brexit Travel – Documentation Requirements

From UK to IRE

UK-based vendors should note the following requirements for travelling to Ireland:

- Valid identification document Passport
- Export Health Certificate
- Negative Coggins Test result for Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA)
- Customs Documentation
 - Import Document (Valuation, Port of Exit, Port of Entry, Ferry Info & Vehicle details)
 - Pre-Board Notification (PBN) and unique Movement Reference Number (MRN)
 - o CHED-A via TRACES system
 - o Single Admin Document (SAD)
- 1. Any equidae travelling from the UK to Ireland is required to have proof of identity in the form of a passport and a readable microchip.
- 2. Health Certification for each Lot is required as standard.
- 3. An **Import Document** is required for all UK-based animals travelling to Ireland. This Import Document is drawn up by **Tattersalls Ireland** for each Lot. Vendors, or their shipping agent, should contact Tattersalls Ireland in relation to same ahead of travel to arrange for the Import Document to be sent to River International (Customs Agent for Tattersalls Ireland). This document will confirm the valuation and travel details which, in turn, generate the required **PBN**, **MRN** and **Valuation**. Once the Import Document is shared with the vendors shipping agent, they will be able to generate the **CHED-A** document on behalf of the vendor.

River International will declare each Lot for import purposes, via a Single Admin Document (SAD). Any VAT in relation to each Lot will then be held on Tattersalls Ireland's Revenue account, pending the Sale outcome. Unsold Lots returning to the UK post-sale, should be notified to Tattersalls Ireland via the Vendors shipping agent. In the event that an unsold Lot stays in Ireland, Tattersalls Ireland will charge the vendors account for the VAT due on import. This will be refunded when documentary evidence of re-export is provided.

From IRE to UK

- Valid identification document Passport
- PVP Health Certificate
- Customs Documentation
 - Import Declaration to Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA)
 - Unique Notification Number (UNN)
 - Commercial Invoice (can be provided by Tattersalls Ireland accounts team accounts@tattersalls.ie)
 - o Export Declaration to Port of Exit in Ireland
