LADY OF GRANGE (IRE): **5 wins**: **winner** of a N.H. Flat Race at 4 years and placed once; also **4 wins** over hurdles and placed 5 times. Above is her first foal.

2nd dam

JUST DONT KNOW: **winner** of a N.H. Flat Race at 5 years; dam of **3 winners**:

Lady of Grange (IRE): see above.

Just Strong (IRE): **2 wins** over fences, 2002 and placed 3 times; also winner of a point-to-point at 6 years and placed once.

Fatalistic (IRE): **winner** over fences, 2001 and placed 5 times; also 2 wins in point-to-points at 6 years, 2000 and placed twice.
