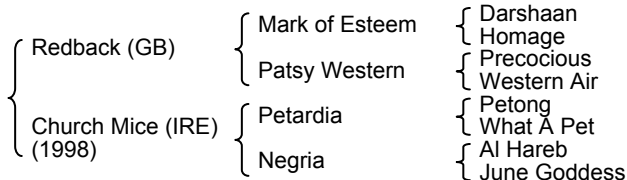




CHESNUT COLT (IRE)
